Local post office branch set to close



a sad loss to the local community

The Post Office has just announced plans to close the local Portobello post office situated on Willenhall Road. The nearest post office branches remaining will be in Bunkers Hill Bilston, John Street Willenhall and the Old Heath branch on Willenhall Road. The Royal Mail claims that the Portobello Post Office serves an average of just 1000 to 1499 customers a week where as the John Street Post Office serves twice that number.

And although the Bunkers Hill branch serves 1000 to 1499 customers weekly it too could face the same demise if the client base fails to increase after the closure of the Portobello branch. "The wave of closures across the West Midlands and nationally has nothing to do with EU rules or the single market. "This is a myth conveniently designed to get Gordon Brown off the hook and it is the local Wolverhampton South East Labour MP who is orchestrating the closures.

There will be a few weeks for 'consultation' before the plan is finalised so your local Liberal Democrat representative Darren Friel and the Focus Team would like to know your views.
