



Residents of Paget Road have contacted Claire Darke and Councillor Robin Lawrence with complaints about the ever increasing amount of litter being dropped particularly in the area of Wolverhampton College and pavements nearby.

In response to these complaints Robin Lawrence has arranged for extra inspections of the area and

for a new litter bin to be installed near to the campus. Claire Darke told Focus Special "I am hopeful that the new bin will help to ease the litter problem for Paget Road residents. I am sad though that residents will have to wait until after April for it to be installed because Labour-controlled

Wolverhampton Council says it does not have enough money to put one in now."

Grass Verge Damage - Signs Ignored

Considerable damage is being done to grass verges all round the West Park because of inconsiderate and inappropriate parking.

Under new powers coming into force at the end of March Wolverhampton Council will be able to fine drivers who park on the grassed areas and pavements. Residents can be assured that Claire Darke, Councillor Robin Lawrence and the Liberal Democrat Focus Team will be pressing the Council to use the new powers to prevent the continuing damage to grass verges around the West Park.
