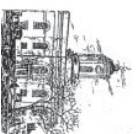

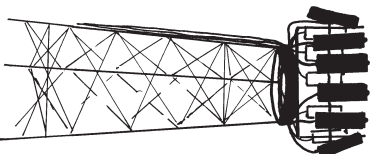

The Focus team organised 7 Saturday collections in 9 months to cover the whole ward.

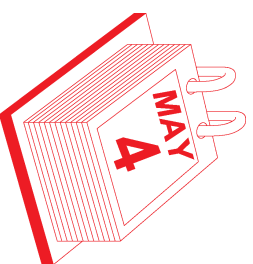

Future Plans

- ▶ Continue the replacement of all street lamps with the more effective halogen lamps.
- ▶ Continue to press the Council to provide team of street wardens and rangers to help combat crime.
- ▶ Press for an upgrade to the poor early central heating systems in Council properties in Springvale
- ▶ Continue making applications for funding to complete door entry systems for all flats and maisonettes.
- ▶ Support the police in eradicating all nuisance from motorcycles on our open spaces.
- ▶ All future telecommunication masts applications in any of our housing estates will be vigorously opposed.
- ▶ Support residents in applications to close or gate nuisance alley ways across the Ward.
- ▶ Pressurise Centro to provide more bus shelters where welcomed by residents.
- ▶ Expect highways to organise a full reinstatement of footpaths where service mains, especially gas, have been replaced across the ward.
- ▶ Support applications for off street parking schemes across Springvale.

OTHER ACHIEVEMENTS

- ▶ New bus shelters in Woodcross.
- ▶ A promise gained from highways to look again at traffic calming for the Ward Grove/Hill Avenue estate.
- ▶ A promise from highways to introduce a 20mph Zone on the Hilton road estate by 2007

Illegal advertising boards removed from The Spread Eagle pub and action started against the illegal hoarding at the top of Meadow Lane.
