£100m EXTRA TO FIX POTHOLES

Oliver Williams has campaigned for potholes in our area to be filled in. Now the Liberal Democrats in government will give local authorities in England an extra £100m to repair potholes caused by December's freezing conditions. Oliver will continue to ensure that the cash that comes to Wolverhampton Council will be used promptly and efficiently to repair our roads. Oliver said, "This money should make a real difference. Even as council budgets are being cut, it is vital that road maintenance is sufficiently funded over the coming years if we are to avoid roads crumbling into disrepair."

Residents recycle food waste

Wolverhampton's citizens have responded brilliantly to the Liberal Democrat food waste initiative by collecting 198 tonnes in the first couple of weeks. Food waste accounts for between 20 and 25 per cent of household waste and if it is not recycled it causes environmentally damaging emissions when it is incinerated or when it goes to a land fill site. Some food waste collected from households around

Wolverhampton is now used to create fertiliser and some will be used to generate electricity that will be put back into the National Grid. The renewable electricity generated will save carbon emissions by replacing electricity generated by fossil-fuelled power stations.
